Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. The NCS captures residents' opinions within the three pillars of a community (Community Characteristics, Governance and Participation) across eight central facets of community (Safety, Mobility, Natural Environment, Built Environment, Economy, Recreation and Wellness, Education and Enrichment and Community Engagement). This report discusses trends over time, comparing the 2018 ratings for the Town of Vienna to its previous survey results in 2014 and 2016 when a comparison was available. Additional reports and technical appendices are available under separate cover.

Trend data for Vienna represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines. Deviations from stable trends over time, especially, represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs or public information may have affected residents' opinions.

For surveys conducted with the same methods and question features over time, meaningful differences would be those with differences greater than 10 percentage points between any given pair of surveys. Vienna's previous two surveys collected data by mail with phone follow-ups and the 2018 survey included mail data collection; phone survey methodology is known to yield more favorable ratings than data collected by mail, so differences over time should be interpreted cautiously. Overall, ratings in Vienna for 2018 generally remained stable. Of the 42 items for which comparisons were available, 35 items were rated similarly in 2016 and 2018, four items showed a decrease in ratings and three showed an increase in ratings.
