



TOWN OF VIENNA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDE

The Town of Vienna Parks and Recreation Department is committed to creating a community through people, parks and programs. Through our Scholarship program, we are making our classes and camps available to all residents of the Town of Vienna.

To be eligible for a scholarship, a child must meet one or more of the following requirements:

1. Receive assistance through one or more of the following programs:
 - a. Free or reduced school lunch
 - b. Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
 - c. Aid for dependent children
 - d. Foster Care
 - e. Medicaid
2. Live in the Town of Vienna
3. Be enrolled in school (kindergarten through 12th grade)
4. Committed to attend the class/camp after the scholarship is awarded.

Scholarships are limited to one program, per person per season, unless otherwise directed by the designated Parks and Recreation Staff. You cannot register for a scholarship online through the WebTrac registration program.

Parents or guardians must fill out the scholarship application along with a Parks and Recreation registration forms, submit to the Scholarship office, along with all official documents signifying the child is receiving aid. The designated Parks and Recreation Staff will determine the scholarship award and then notify the parent or guardian of the status. The scholarship is only good for one season. A new scholarship application and registration form must be submitted for each season (Winter/Spring/Summer/Fall).

Scholarship requests through the local Elementary/Middle/High Schools will be awarded through a separate process. The designated Parks and Recreation Staff and the school counselors work together to award scholarships through this process. Children cannot receive a scholarship through the school AND through the Vienna Parks and Recreation Department.
