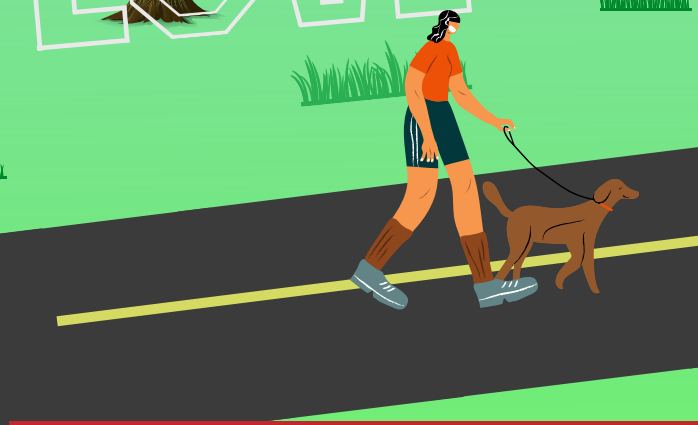

Branch Road Tot Lot

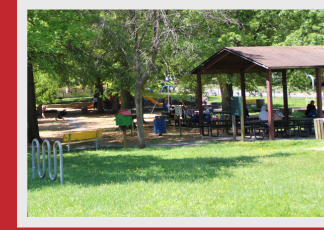
Locust St. and Branch Rd., SE

Glyndon Park

Meadow Lane Park

Moorefield Park

1317 Ross Dr., SW

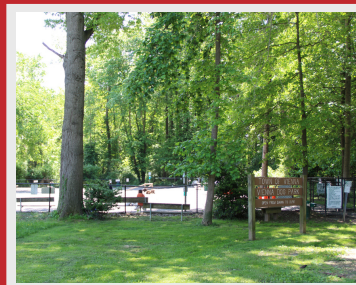
Southside Park features multiple courts and fields for sports. The park hosts softball, baseball and football leagues and is the site of the annual 4th of July Fireworks display.

700 Courthouse Rd., SW

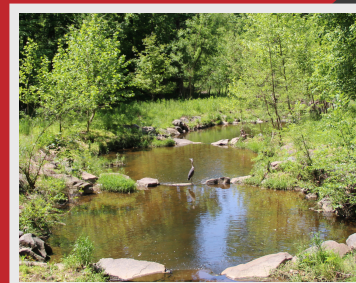
This fenced in park provides a cool, safe off-leash area for dogs to play shaded by mature trees. Water is available on site.
