Shooting Incident

In the early morning hours of October 7, 2021 (12:36 a.m.), the Vienna Police Department received a 911 call regarding a shooting in the Navy Federal Credit Union parking lot, located at 801 Follin Lane, SE. When officers arrived, they found a male victim who had been shot in the upper torso. Officers immediately called for rescue while rendering immediate care for the victim's non-life-threatening wounds. Shortly after arriving on the scene, officers searched for the shooting suspect. With the assistance of the Fairfax County Police Department K9 unit and helicopter, the suspect was located nearby and taken into custody. The suspect, Kwame Adjei, 25 years old, of Manassas, Va., was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he was charged with malicious wounding and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. He is being held without bond. Investigators believe the shooting was related to a dispute between the suspect and victim. There appears to be no on-going threat to the community.
