Town Works to Provide Relief to Ukrainian Refugees

Vienna Mayor Linda Colbert joined other Northern Virginia elected leaders at the Fairfax County Government Center today to help launch a multi-jurisdictional relief effort to support Ukrainian refugees. Beginning today through April 15, residents who wish to help may drop off the following relief supplies at the Vienna Community Center:

- New or gently used coats
- New blankets
- New pairs of heavy socks or sweat socks
- New pairs of gloves

"We have all watched in horror the atrocities the Ukrainian people have suffered as a result of the Russian invasion of their country," Vienna Mayor Linda Colbert said. "By working with our regional neighbors, we can collectively make a bigger impact on providing much-needed supplies to help Ukrainian refugees survive this crisis."

Once the drive concludes, the donated items will be picked up and shipped to Poland for distribution to Ukrainian refugees there. The regional aid drive was organized by the Northern Virginia Regional Commission.
