Town of Vienna Wins Three National Communications Awards

For the second year in a row, the Town of Vienna is getting national recognition with three Blue Pencil and Gold Screen Awards from the National Association of Government Communicators (NAGC). The awards were announced April 19 at the organization's annual conference in Portland, Oregon.

The Town was recognized for excellence in the digital e-newsletter category taking first place for the "Vienna Happenings" weekly e-newsletter. The publication, written by communications specialist Caleb Lester, highlights upcoming events and activities in the Town of Vienna, and Caleb's efforts to update the publication's look and feel were recognized as key factors in a growing subscription rate and a very high open rate. The Town of Vienna also took first place in the video documentary category for the "What's Your Story" segment called "The Gravy Lady," featuring Vienna resident Shirley Martin. The video, produced by Sean Metzger, documents the beloved, 97-year-old resident's memories of growing up in Vienna and her continued service to the Vienna community through the American Legion's Post 180 Ladies Auxiliary. Second-place video honors went to the Town for "Liberty Minutes."
