- No loud music
- No motorized vehicles
- No sale of food, beverages, or other goods or services
- No charging of fees for any activities or services

- Pets must be on leash
- Pick-up and properly dispose of all trash
- Use grills provided and leave all charcoal in the grill after use
- No cutting or removal of trees
- Permits will be issued for up to 5-hours
