# What is a Parks and Recreation Master Plan?

A strategic, comprehensive effort to outline the long-term vision, goals, and objectives for the development, enhancement, and management of parks, open spaces, and recreational facilities within a community



# What is a Parks and Recreation Master Plan?

#### What this plan will do:

- ✓ Assess of the health of the "system"
- ✓ Identify service gaps and opportunities for improvement
- ✓ Establish a vision, supported by shared values and goals
- ✓ Provide near- (1 to 5 years), mid-(6 to 8 years) and long-term (9 to 10 years) strategies

#### What this plan will not do:

- Fund or construct a project
- Develop detailed site design proposals for every park



# What is Vienna's Parks and Recreation Master Plan:

#### A Plan that...

- emphasizes and enhances what makes Vienna unique
- provides equitable, fair and inclusive opportunities for all ages and abilities
- has a vision informed by community input
- supports growth in the town
- advises future decision-making
- is fiscally responsible
- is implementable, with a transparent and flexible roadmap


