Town of Vienna Police Department Arrests Hit and Run Suspect

On November 28, 2024, officers from the Vienna Police Department responded to a hit-and-run accident in the 900 block of Park St SE. Upon arrival, they discovered that a pedestrian had been struck while attempting to cross the street. Detectives also responded to the scene and found evidence linking the incident to the vehicle involved, which was identified as a 2003 Chevrolet Avalanche pickup truck.

Further investigation led detectives to an address in New Kent County, VA, on November 30, 2024, where they located the vehicle, showing damage consistent with the hit-and-run crash. The truck was seized, and a search warrant was executed, uncovering additional evidence.

On December 10, 2024, detectives obtained a felony hit-and-run warrant for Chad Gaskill, the driver of the vehicle. Gaskill voluntarily turned himself into Vienna Police Detectives on December 11, 2024, and was held on a \$10,000 secured bond at the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center.
