### **Results of the 28<sup>th</sup> National Drug Take Back Initiative**

On April 26, 2025, the Town of Vienna Police Department partnered with the United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) for the 28th National Prescription Drug Take Back Initiative. This event successfully resulted in the collection and proper disposal of 358 pounds of expired or unnecessary medications from residents.

In April, the statewide initiative gathered approximately 16,416 pounds of medication, highlighting the community's commitment to responsible medication disposal.

The Vienna Police Department remains dedicated to collaborating with the DEA in future Drug Take Back events, reinforcing its efforts to promote safe and effective medication disposal practices.
