May Flowers Usher in Spring Native Plant Sale

Three great things happen on the first Saturday in May this year – The Kentucky Derby, opening day of the Vienna Farmer’s Market and the Spring Native Plant Sale sponsored by the Town of Vienna Conservation and Sustainability Commission (CSC)!

The sale will be held on Saturday, May 3, 2025, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Vienna Community Center, 120 Cherry St., SE, and will feature seasonal plants that are native to the region. All plants are raised and sold by Hill House Garden Nursery and include flowering perennials, native shrubs, and small trees available for purchase. During the sale, attendees can get gardening tips, enter in a free drawing for a rain barrel and a compost bin and take advantage of the composting booth operated by Monster Organics and drop off food waste.

The Community Center parking lot will also be busy as vendors set up for the 2025 Vienna Farmers Market opening day. The market opens at 8 a.m., and local dignitaries will do the official opening-day honors when they cut the ribbon at 10 a.m. The market offers regionally sourced fresh produce, honey, homemade goods and more. Vienna Farmers Market hours are Saturdays, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m., May through October.
